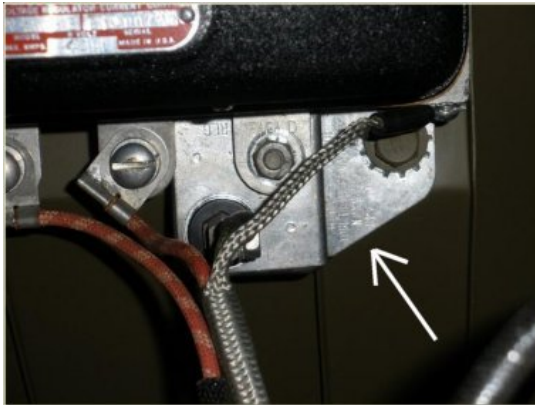
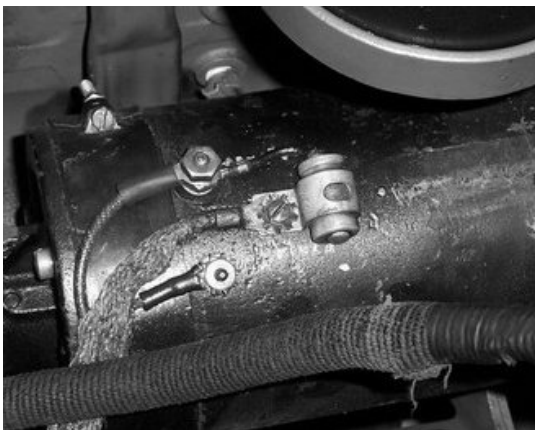


G503 WWII 1942 Willys MB Type I Radio Suppression

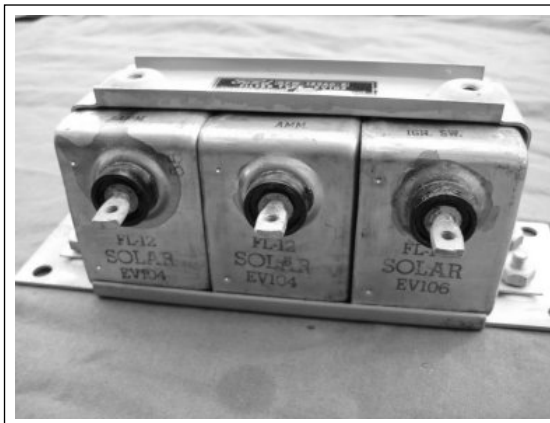
Nabholtz shows as Type I suppression ending in Dec 43 with MB serial # 289001. Here is a list of filters that you need for the Type I Suppression.
WO-A-1287 filter, mounted to dash side of voltage regulator



WO-A-5337 filter unit, .1 MFD, generator ground to armature circuit mounts on the screw for the generator ground and attaches to the armature terminal of the generator.



WO-A-1517 Filterette. This mounts under the glove box dash.



The internals of the filterette above are shown here.
